Special Rules for the Open Fine Arts Department:

(Please see General Rules for additional information.)

1. Entry Fees are not refundable for each exhibit submitted.
2. Maximum Entries: 3 (total of three per artist).
3. Eligibility: 18 and older, Arizona resident (Artist who winter in Arizona are eligible).

4. Exhibitors entering in the Open Fine Arts section are not eligible to enter the Amateur Fine Arts section.
5. This is a juried art show; some items entered may not be accepted for show.
6. All work must be original, entered and created by the artist within the last three years, and must not have been exhibited at any previous Arizona State Fair Fine Arts Exhibition.
7. Computer generated, photographic prints, copies and color copies are not allowed.
8. Entries must be delivered unpacked, wired, and ready for hanging. No sawtooth hangers allowed. Glass or Plexiglas accepted. No frosted glass. **Items will be refused until properly prepared and wired for hanging.**
9. It shall be the responsibility of the jury to eliminate entries improperly entered. Artists must classify their own entries, selecting from the printed classifications.
10. **Nude or obscene violent entries will not be accepted. Management and judges reserve the right to remove entries, which are considered obscene or harmful to minors, as defined in the Arizona Criminal Code.**
11. If there are less than (8) items in a class, those items may be combined with similar classes for judging purposes.
12. All accepted artwork will be exhibited in the Fine Arts Exhibition until the art release dates at the end of the fair. All accepted artwork may not be removed from the exhibit until these dates.
13. The Fair agrees to assume full responsibility for all entries and to insure against loss or damage, to repair or pay fair market value for the entry, from the time the entry is dropped off or picked up. In the event of loss or damage the Fair's maximum liability will be limited to the agreed value as stated on the entry, until returned to Entrant.
14. Artists living more than 100 miles from the Fairgrounds may wait until releasing day to pick up both their accepted and non-accepted entries. Please be aware that there may be events on the grounds, you will be directed by gate attendants.
15. The Arizona State Fair and its Board will not be responsible for items left for more than 10 days after the final pick-up date.

**CLASS LISTINGS FOR FINE ARTS AND
AMATEUR FINE ARTS**

Class 601 – Painting

Painting with oils, tempera, lacquer, encaustic and related painting mediums not previously listed in any subject. Must be framed or use wrap-around canvas. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame.

Class 602 – Painting: Acrylic

Painting with acrylics in any subject. Must be framed or use wrap-around canvas. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame.

Class 603 – Pastels

Color or black and white pastels in any theme. Must be under glass or Plexiglas with mat and frame. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame.

Class 604 – Watercolor Painting

Painting with watercolor paint using any theme. Must be under glass or Plexiglas with mat and frame. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame.

Class 605 – Sculpture: Free Standing

Three dimensional art sculpted in the round and free standing in any subject. Single or mixed media. No mobiles. Must not exceed 500 pounds. Please denote medium.

Class 606 – Sculpture: Wall Hanging

Three dimensional art sculpted in relief in any subject. Single or mixed media. No mobiles. Must be wired and framed properly for hanging. Must not exceed 100 pounds. Please denote medium.

Class 607 – Drawing: Color

Drawing in color in any subject. Must be under glass or Plexiglas with mat and frame. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame.

Class 608 - Drawing: Black and White

Drawing in black and white in any subject. Must be under glass or Plexiglas with mat and frame. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame.

Class 609 - Mixed Media

Two dimensional art using a combination of two or more mediums in any subject. Must be under glass or Plexiglas with mat and frame. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame. Must not exceed 100 pounds. Please denote medium.

Class 610 – Printmaking

Hand pulled by artist monoprints, linocut, etching, wood cut, lithography, silk screen in any subject. (Original art only. No commercial prints, color copies, photography prints, or computer generated prints.) Must be under glass or Plexiglas with mat and frame. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame. Please denote printmaking medium.

Class 611 – Ceramics

Must be handmade and fired. No molds. May be decorative or utilitarian, but of original, creative design.

Class 612 – Porcelain Painting

Painting must be on high fired porcelain body, either commercial or handmade. May be decorative or utilitarian, but or original, creative design.

Class 613 – Graphic Art / Illustration

Graphic Art: illustration, cartooning, caricature, calligraphy, fashion illustration, commercial art, in any two dimensional medium. Must be under glass or Plexiglas with mat and frame. Must be wired properly for hanging; no sawtooth hangers. Maximum size 54” in either dimension, including frame.

Class 614 – Theme of the Year 2009: Arizona Animals

Any medium. (See guidelines for chosen medium listed above.) Artistic interpretation of the selected theme of the year.
