The show will be judged by the System of Awarding as set forth by the National Council of State Garden Clubs, Inc. Decision of the judges is final. Membership in National Council State Garden Clubs or any organization is not necessary for exhibitors.

Special Rules for this Department

Please see General Rules for further instruction

1. No entries will be accepted after the specified entry deadline. Be sure to list on your official entry form all divisions and class numbers, which you expect to enter.
2. No entry may be entered for more than one premium, and only one entry may be entered in each class.
3. Entries must be received prior to 9:00am on Receiving Day. All cars must be removed from grounds by 9:00am prior to opening of the Fair.
4. Reservations: All classes, other than Individual Horticultural entries, require that reservations for space be made with one of the superintendents prior to sending entry form to the entry office.
5. Plants, containers, etc., can be taken before 10:00 am releasing day. The staff is not responsible for exhibits left after 12:00 pm releasing day.
6. Any exhibitor wishing to send exhibits by mail or express should first notify the superintendent. All charges to be prepaid by exhibitor.
7. All Horticulture entries will become the property of the Fair and will not be returned to exhibitors, with the exception of potted plants.

Onsite entries will be accepted and are subject to an additional onsite entry fee, by approval of the department Superintendent and/or the Competitive Entries Director.

Labeling

8. All plants and cut specimens shall be labeled with plant name. Containers for cut specimens will be furnished by the department.

9. All containers for artistic arrangements and potted plants must have name and address attached to the bottom of the container.
10. Entries improperly classified will not be changed or judged.
- 12'' wings. Backgrounds for small designs will be furnished by State Fair.
23. Bases and accessories may be used in all classes, unless otherwise specified. All accessories are used at the exhibitor's risk.

Judging

11. Judges will award such premiums as exhibits merit. If any entries are judged not worthy of a premium, the judges will make no award.
12. In "Any Other" class where three or more exhibits of one variety are shown and named, the Superintendent may, if deemed necessary, create one or more classes. This will allow exhibits to be judged in their own category.
13. Judging is closed to the public.
14. The decision of the judges shall in all cases be final.
15. Only the judge's books will be used as evidence for payment of premiums. Ribbons or tags are not accepted as proof of results.

Designs & Staging (Floral)

16. Heights of design should not be less than 30" or more than 36".
17. Arrangements using artificial flowers or foliage will not be accepted for judging, except where specified.
18. Arrangements may be of all dried materials, all fresh materials, or combination of both, unless otherwise specified in a particular class.
19. Dried material may be treated, any plant material that has had the surface, texture, color or substance changed, is considered to have been treated. The change may be affected by an application of any substance, such as wax, dye, paint, shellac, lacquer, oil, flocking, plastic spray, etc. Fresh plant material cannot be treated in any manner.
20. Plant material need not be grown by the exhibitor, accessories are permitted.
21. All fresh material must have an ample water supply available to insure good condition throughout the display period. Fair reserves the right to remove any entry if its appearance is unsuited to remain on exhibit. Conditioning of flowers and foliage is advised. You may bring extra blooms to have your display refurbished.
22. Exhibitor may furnish own background, 36" high by 24" wide. Fair triptych 36" high x 24" with

Special Awards

- **Award of Horticultural Excellence** may be awarded to the named exhibit, judged to be the finest in the entire Horticulture Division in each of the four shows. This award shall be represented by a rosette of green, orange, and blue ribbons.
- **Sweepstakes Rosette** and \$25.00 will be given to the Exhibitor with the greatest number of blue ribbons in each category Roses, Mini Roses, Flowers & Branches.
- **Artistic Sweepstakes Rosette** of green & white ribbon and \$25.00 will be given to the Exhibitor with the greatest number of blue ribbons in Design, Mini Design & Hanging Decorations.
- **Golden Years Rosette** awarded to eldest exhibitor in the Department.

The following awards may be given to a blue ribbon winner in each section indicated with a score of 95 or over. There must be a minimum of three (3) qualifying divisions; with at least four (4) entries in each class:

- **Atrium Rosette** is awarded in Division 702, Class 101 with a scoring of 95 or more.
- **Educational Award** may be awarded to a blue ribbon winning exhibit in Division 701. This award shall be represented by a rosette of brown & white.
- **Award of Distinction** is awarded in Division 703, Class 104 or 105 and shall be represented by a brown rosette.
- **Designer's Choice Award** represented by a rosette of purple ribbons in Division 703 Class 103, 704, 718, 732, and 747.
- **Petite Award** represented by a small rosette of blue and white ribbons maybe awarded in Division 705, 719, 733 and 748.
- **Award of Merit** may be awarded to a named blue ribbon winning exhibit in Division 707, 709, 721, 735 and 750. This award shall be represented by a rosette of orange ribbon.
- **Collectors Showcase Award** maybe given to a

blue ribbon winner in division 702 represented by a rosette of brown & green.

- **Arboreal Award** may be awarded to a named blue ribbon winning exhibit in Division 708, 722, 737 and 751. This award shall be represented by a rosette of two shades of green ribbon.
- **Queen of the Show** - The best rose chosen from Division 710, 723, 738 and 752 to be represented by a gold rosette.
- **King of the Show** - The second best rose chosen from Division 710, 723, 738 and 752 to be represented by a silver rosette.
- **Princess of the Show** - The third best rose chosen from Division 710, 723, 738 and 752 to be represented by a bronze rosette.
- **Prince of the Show** - single specimen - Best Grandiflora from Division 711, 724, 739 and 753 to be represented by a blue rosette.
- **Duke of the Show** - Best single floribunda in Division 713, 726, 741 and 755 to be represented by a white rosette.
- **Duchess of the Show** - Best spray floribunda in Division 712, 725, 740 and 754 to be represented by a pink rosette.
- **Mini Queen of Show** - Best rose chosen from Division 715, 728, 742 and 756 to be represented by a mini gold rosette.
- **Mini King of Show** - The second best rose chosen from Division 715, 728, 742 and 756 to be represented by a mini silver rosette.
- **Mini Princess of Show** - The third best rose chosen from Division 715, 728, 742 and 756 to be represented by a mini bronze rosette.
- **Mini Duchess of the Show** - Best mini spray in Division 716, 729, 743 and 757 to be represented by a mini pink rosette.
